- Users can customize the Waiting Room by uploading a video. This enables meeting attendees to watch pre-recorded videos to the start of the meeting
- Transfer meetings between devices

March/April 2021

- <u>Immersive View:</u> Recreate the feel of your classroom, conference room or choose from several other scene options, by placing video participants onto a single virtual background. Participants are automatically placed onto provided scenes, but the host can upload their own custom background and adjust the arrangements as needed.
- Full Emoji Suite: If the meeting reactions feature is enabled, account owners and admins can allow meeting participants to <u>use all emojis</u> or a predefined set of 6 emojis.
